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AccuStar Labs has developed these instructions according to Florida-Department of Health and the EPA. These instructions must be followed correctly in order to receive valid test results. All the information requested on the Data Sheet is mandatory. If you have questions about these instructions, call AccuStar Labs at 888-480-8812 before you begin the test. Professional testers using AccuStar Labs test kits must be certified by Florida DoH and affiliated with AccuStar prior to testing. Certified testers must perform the required monthly amount of QC tests and must report these to AccuStar each month.

Prepare for Testing

1. Include 10% duplicates and 5% field blanks.
2. Closed house/building conditions must be maintained. All windows and external doors should remain closed (except for brief opening of doors necessary for normal entry and exit) FOR 12 HOURS PRIOR TO AND DURING MEASUREMENT PERIOD.
3. Leave radon mitigation system operating. (if applicable)
4. Set HVAC systems to "Auto" and set window A/C units to recirculate. Dehumidifiers may be operated during test.
5. Do not operate whole house exhaust fans, wood or coal stoves (unless they are the primary source of heat).
6. Unusual weather conditions affect test results. Do not perform the test during sustained high winds, heavy rain or extreme indoor conditions of heat, cold or humidity. Check your local weather forecast to ensure measurement is scheduled during satisfactory weather conditions.
7. Short term tests should not be placed in areas of high humidity. If humidity is unavoidable, tests placed in humid areas should not be exposed for more than 72 hours (3 days). A longer test duration may invalidate results.
8. Tests should not be conducted while building is undergoing remodeling or other modifications, including HVAC system modifications.
9. Air exchange systems (other than furnaces) should not be operation for 12 hours prior to and during testing.
10. Devices must be exposed for 2 to 4 days (no less than 48 hours and no more than 96 hours) Exposure of less than 48 hours or more than 96 hours will invalidate results

Placement

1. As a guideline, the devices should be placed at a minimum of one device every 2000 square feet of open space.
2. DO NOT place devices in bathrooms, kitchens, boiler rooms, closets, crawlspaces, storage areas or any areas with high humidity. Avoid placing devices on stone surfaces, such as granite or marble.
3. Keep devices away from excessive heat, outside walls, and/or drafts caused by HVAC vents, windows, doors, direct sunlight and high humidity.
4. Choose a location that is at least 3 feet from any door, wall or window, 2 feet from the floor or ceiling and 4 inches from other objects. Do not place devices directly under blowing air.

How to Perform the Test

Don't open the device until you are ready to test. Start the test before the expiration date.

Exposure time restraints: 48-96 hours for LS and Canisters

1. Remove the lid (and tape, if a canister) from the device.
2. Record the Device Numbers from the device. Record the open date and time on the datasheet. Include AM or PM. Sign the Data Sheet.
3. Place device on hard surface with open side up in the selected location.
4. After the recommended test duration, close the device. For canisters, replace the vinyl tape around the seams. If the vinyl tape is lost, use electrical tape to seal. Record the close date and time on data sheet. Include AM or PM. Sign the data sheet again.
5. You must provide ALL information on the Data Sheet in order to receive results. Any corrections or additions to the data sheet must be sent to us in writing. An Amended report will be issued within 5 business days. Same-Day Amended Test Reports can be issued for an additional fee.
6. Place the devices and completed datasheet in a package. Mail the devices immediately. We must receive the device within 7 days of the closing date.
